Overview

Please create a WordPress plugin called “Easy Call To Action Buttons”.

This plugin will allow users to create CSS buttons via shortcodes.

The plugin will not have a user interface.

There's two required components

- the file that handles our shortcode
- our css file

1. The shortcode

Basic button

`[easy-button]Button Text[/easy-button]`

example:

`[easy-button]Download Now[/easy-button]`

Optional Attributes

1.

link - specifies the url that the button should link to(href)

default value: #

2.

color - determines the button color

options

- blue (default)
 - background-color: #3498db
 - background-color on hover: #2980b9
- red
 - background-color: #e74c3c

- background-color on hover: #c0392b
- orange
 - background-color: #e67e22
 - background-color on hover: #d35400
- green
 - background-color: #2ecc71
 - background-color on hover: #27ae60
- yellow
 - background-color: #f1c40f
 - background-color on hover: #f39c12
- purple
 - background-color: #9b59b6
 - background-color on hover: #8e44ad

3.

size - determines the size of the button

options:

- tiny
- small
- medium (default)
- large

Examples

- [easy-button]Download Now[/easy-button]
- [easy-button]Download Now[/easy-button]
- [easy-button size="tiny" link="/checkout"]Download Now[/easy-button]
- [easy-button link="/checkout"]Add To Cart[/easy-button]
- [easy-button color="yellow" link="/checkout"]Download Now[/easy-button]
- [easy-button size="large" color="purple" link="http://myurl.com/purchase"]Purchase[/easy-button]
